# **CEO Report**

A verbal update was provided to the Board. Highlights include:

- Following presentation of the Nursing Advisory Council Report, the Board approved it.

## Northern Health Region Foundation

The Flin Flon Rotary Club's airshow on July 13th was a success with the Foundation to be the largest beneficiary of the proceeds in support of the Flin Flon General Hospital (FFGH) Emergency Department (ED) Redevelopment Project. The Foundation is currently applying for a grant from CIBC. The Royal Bank (RBC Foundation) is donating \$1,000 to the FFGH ED Redevelopment Project. A local business will be presenting a \$5,000 cheque at the FFGH ED Redevelopment Project sod turning event.
