Meeting Details

Meetings took place in November 2017 and January 2018. In attendance at these meetings were 4 LHIG members in November and 3 LHIG members in January, 4 NHR Members and 1 Board Member. The topic of discussion was "Gaps in Community Mental Health".

At the November meeting the Community Mental Health program provided an educational presentation: "Northern Health Region Services-internal and external supports".

A question and answer session followed the presentation with Community Mental Health Manager and Executive Leadership participating in the discussion. This gave the LHIG participants an opportunity to ask questions and gain additional knowledge on this topic.

Homework questionnaires were utilized by the LHIGs to gain more community consultation for the group. LHIG members returned completed questionnaires.

At the January meeting the 18 received questionnaires were themed to help the LHIG participants identify strategic community mental health gaps in their area.
