◆ Staff will respond to requests for assessment, consultation, or support regarding a youth in crisis due to a mental health problem, suicide or substance misuse concern.

Services are available to:

- ♦ Youth aged 17 and younger living in Northern Manitoba.
- ♦ Caregivers and/or agencies concerned about a youth in crisis.

Mobile Crisis Team

Crisis Stabilization Unit

The Crisis Stabilization Unit provides short-term, community-based supportive care and services for individuals in psychiatric or psychosocial crisis. Referrals are welcome from parents/guardians, caregivers, mental health-care professionals, service providers and other concerned individuals. The CSU provides a safe environment for youth to take a break from current life circumstances, where they'll receive support, encouragement and skills to improve quality of life.

Youth Addictions Stabilization Unit

Provides short-term support to caregivers with a child/youth 17 years of age and under who is misusing substances, where the use is severe and there is concern of risk and harm if intervention does not occur.
