1. Situation Summary

a. First Nations Communities

- (1) 10 remain open, 53 are closed to non-essential staff/supplies.
- (2) 19 health care facilities open, 37 offering limited services, 9 closed.
- (3) 28 health care facilities have COVID-19 test sites. All 24 ISC health care facilities have adequate lab supplies.

b. Winnipeg. Nothing significant to report.

c. Manitoba

- (1) Public health officials advise **one** additional cases of COVID-19 have been identified **since May 29th**. This brings the total number of lab-confirmed positive and probable positive COVID-19 cases in Manitoba to **295 (10 active cases)**. Seven individuals have died, no individuals are in hospital, and **278 individuals have recovered**. No cases have been identified in First Nations communities.

2. FNIHB EOC Activities

- a. Monitor the second shipments of isolation kits by Canadian Red Cross to 53 First Nations communities and one Tribal Council (on behalf of eight FN communities) who have requested kits. Two First Nations communities have opted out. Isolation kits include cots, pillows, blankets, towels, personal hygiene kits, cleaning supplies, masks, gloves, and safety kits, with other PPE and thermometers to be added shortly. Ongoing.
- b. Facilitate a training session with the Rapid Response Team from the FN COVID-19 Pandemic Response Team on the public health follow-up process. Ongoing.
- c. **Conduct training sessions (by request) on PPE and terminal cleaning for support staff at isolation and quarantine sites in FN communities. Closed.**
- d. Conduct training sessions with housekeeping staff at nursing stations in FN communities on the use of newly available cleaning products. Ongoing.
- e. Contact FN communities to discuss their readiness to implement their respective pandemic plans. Ongoing.
- f. Distribute thermometers for use in FN communities at nursing stations, health centres, personal care homes, and isolation sites. Ongoing.
