SUMMARY

The Patient Care Coordinator will work closely with the Northern Patient Transportation Program (NPTP) Regional Manager, NPTP staff, physicians, clinics and emergency departments in the coordination of patient transportation for the region. The primary focus is to ensure that the program is delivered in the most consistent and cost-effective manner possible. The Patient Care Coordinator will be responsible for the day to day assessment of patient transportation requirements. The position will also be responsible for analyzing patient travel trends, making recommendations on specialty services that could be provided in the community and other ways to reduce patient travel requirements/costs.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing preferred
- Current active practicing registration with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (CRNM)
- Must have a valid Manitoba Class V drivers license, access to a vehicle, and willingness to travel within the region and province year round

- Knowledge of the NPTP and associated patient transportation policies, procedures and issues
