Utilizes advanced skills and knowledge and performs at a high level of independence as a Best Practice Educator, leader, and consultant. Provides direct care as required. Must have the ability to work in an environment that promotes and is conducive to all patients (medical, surgical, pediatric, obstetrical, and behavioural health). The majority of work will be alongside the staff as the Best Practice Educator assists in building skills and abilities.
