POSITION SUMMARY

Reporting to the Director, Primary Care & Clinics, the Regional Wound Care Coordinator assumes leadership responsibility for the development and management of a Regional Wound Care Program. This includes quality management relating to client outcomes and efficiencies, performance improvement and standardization of best practices, education needs of clients and staff, product monitoring, evaluation/procurement, and research for the Wound Care Program within the Northern Health Region.

Works closely with all clinical, quality, infection prevention and control programs as well as the Nursing Practice Council and Wound Care Committee (to be formed), to support programs in the development, implementation, coordination, evaluation of wound care prevention and management strategies. Responsibilities include acting as a resource internally and externally; providing education and recommendations for wound care and ultimately achieving program metrics demonstrating the value of implementing prevention and best management practices for wounds. The incumbent is an active member of the multidisciplinary regional wound care team.

Works within a variety of settings including Primary Health Care Clinics, Home and Palliative Care, Personal Care Homes and Acute Care within the Northern Health Region. The position of Regional Wound Care Coordinator functions in a manner consistent with, and supports the mission, vision and values of the Northern Health Region.

The incumbent must fulfill the requirements of the Criminal Records/Vulnerable Person, Child Abuse Registry check and Adult Abuse Registry check, and adhere to all Northern Health Region policies and procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing required
- Current active practicing registration with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (CRNM) and the Regulated Professionals Act
- Completion of Certificate of International Inter-professional Wound Care Course (IIWCC): Advanced Knowledge required.
- Current certification from a recognized Health Care Provider Basic Life Support (BLS), or obtain within three (3) months of commencing employment
- Thorough knowledge of Windows based programs (Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook) and Internet, including web based resources (Absorb, Lexicomp, Mosby's)
- Minimum of four (4) years recent clinical nursing experience in advanced wound care management
- Minimum of two (2) years recent experience in performing ankle brachial index (ABI/ABPI)
- Valid Manitoba Class 5 driver's license, access to a vehicle, and willingness to travel the region year round
- Satisfactory employment record required
- Successful candidate subject to provide security checks in accordance with Security Checks for Employment Policy (HR-02-80. Waived for internal candidates with current checks on file.
