Guided by the NHR Public Health Principles, including health equity, harm reduction and a commitment to outreach and nonjudgmental services, this position will strive to improve the health status of the residents of the Northern health Region (NHR) working from an advanced understanding and knowledge of Disease Management, harm reduction, population health, determinants of health, and case management delivered within a public health framework. Develops and implements health strategies from a trauma informed care and client centered strength/holistic approach.
