### POSITION SUMMARY

The Audiologist, a member of Rehabilitative Services, is responsible for all aspects of the Audiology program and services. Emphasizes early identification of hearing loss, prevention of hearing loss, hearing health promotion and rehabilitation in an attempt to minimize the negative impact of hearing loss. Plays an important role in enhancing and maintaining information sharing and collaboration between community-based, school-based and hospital services. The major focus of the position will be the assessment and treatment of children while also working with all age groups. Provides clinical supervision to the Audiology Assistant and the Newborn Hearing Screeners.
