POSITION SUMMARY

The Community Engagement Liaison assists in building relationships of trust and rapport with culturally diverse communities to enhance their capacity to overcome barriers to accessing timely and appropriate care for the cancer control. Collaborates with health care facilities, local groups, organizations, and institutions to promote equity and inclusiveness in cancer care and assists in ensuring that the regional cancer strategy considers, integrates, and meets the needs of under-served populations. Works in a collaborative, shared care model with the Regional Health Authority (RHA), the regional Navigation Team, and Cancer Care Manitoba (CCMB).
