POSITION SUMMARY

The Occupational Therapist (OT) is responsible for the provision of occupational therapy assessment and treatment of adult and/or pediatric in-patients, out-patients, Long Term Care residents, and Primary Health Care clients. Travel to schools and community settings may be required.

The OT practice will be based upon a client-centered approach that emphasizes the involvement of clients and caregivers in defining optimal health, function, treatment and goal development.
