What is Supportive Housing?

- Supportive Housing offers a unique community living approach for seniors who require some personal attention and additional support in their day-to-day activities.

Who is Supportive Housing for?

- Supportive Housing is the right choice for medically stable seniors who want the freedom and privacy of living in suites combined with innovative support and care options. Our unique community living approach was designed to empower clients by providing a positive family-like environment while enabling them to maintain their own private space decorated with their own furniture and belongings.

Supportive Housing Questions and Answers

What services do I receive?

- Supportive Housing employees offer assistance with daily activities such as hygiene, dressing, bathing, medication reminders, meals, and recreation. The environment is not medical or clinical, but rather supportive in a way that is tailored to the needs and choices of residents.
- We offer homestyle meal services and all meals are prepared fresh onsite. Each floor has a comfortable dining room where residents share meals together. There are three(3) meals and two(2) snacks a day which are served family-style.



What recreational activities are provided?

- An exceptional recreational program is available to provide physical activity, socialization, and friendship including activities such as:
 - Movements that matter*
 - Music therapy*
 - Indoor bowling*
 - Arts and crafts*
 - Puzzles; and*
 - Outings*

What is the cost?

- Fees include a monthly base rate plus 30% of income based off of the client's Notice of Assessment. Rates increase every year and rent is due at the beginning of every month.

Is smoking allowed?

- No, smoking is not allowed in Supportive Housing units.
